## **Novack and Macey Secures Trial Victory for Recording Artist**

Novack and Macey won a resounding victory at trial on behalf of its client, a professional recording artist. The artist's former record label alleged, among other things, that she breached her recording contract by not participating in the marketing of her album and by recording with another label. The record company also alleged that the artist wrongfully interfered with a contract between the plaintiff and one of its staff producers. The plaintiff sought damages of approximately five million dollars and an order prohibiting the artist from performing or recording for nine years.

After a two day bench trial, Judge William O. Maki of the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois entered judgment in favor of the artist against plaintiff on all counts.
