## **Novack and Macey's E-Discovery Attorney Marie Lim Follows Trends in Emerging Practice Area**

Marie V. Lim, Novack and Macey's E-Discovery Attorney, represented the firm at the First Annual Electronic Discovery and Digital Practitioner's Workshop held May 19-20, 2010, in Chicago. The workshop was sponsored by the E-Discovery and Digital Evidence (EDDE) Committee of the American Bar Association's Section on Science and Technology Law.

Topics included the Seventh Circuit Electronic Discovery Pilot Program, trends and developments in searching electronically-stored information (ESI) and emerging digital evidence issues.
