Eric Macey Quoted in StreetWise on The Posse Foundation

Eric Macey, firm co-founder, was quoted in an recent edition of *StreetWise*, a weekly magazine sold by Chicago's poor and homeless population. The magazine's cover story was on The Posse Foundation where Eric serves as a volunteer. He is the Chairman of The Posse Foundation in Chicago and a member of the Foundation's National Board.

The Posse Foundation identifies public high school students with extraordinary academic and leadership potential who may be overlooked by traditional college selection processes. The Foundation extends to these students the opportunity to pursue personal and academic excellence by placing them in supportive, multicultural teams ("Posses") of 10 students. The Foundation's partner universities award Posse Scholars four-year, full-tuition leadership scholarships

Eric spoke at an awards ceremony in January 2011 where 85 Chicago high school students learned they were winners of four-year, full scholarships to partner schools. The *StreetWise* article quoted Eric's view that "institutions of higher education depend on Posse to send high caliber students who will reflect an increasingly diverse United States." He said meeting this need has made Posse "a singular change agent of the past quarter century."

Eric told the students: "Some man or woman you will never know wrote a check for \$5 or \$50,000 because they care about diversity in the world and making you the leaders of the next generation. They give you this opportunity to transform you and transform this country too."
