E-Discovery Attorney Marie Lim Named to Seventh Circuit Electronic Discovery Pilot Program Committee

[Marie Lim](#), Novack and Macey's E-Discovery Attorney, has been named to the Seventh Circuit Electronic Discovery Pilot Program Committee.

The Committee was formed in 2009 to conduct a multi-year process of developing, implementing, evaluating and improving the pretrial discovery process. The goal was to reduce the cost and burden of e-discovery. The Committee first developed a set of principles to guide discovery of electronically stored information. It also established a Standing Order, allowing participating judges to implement those principles in test cases. The Pilot Program is now in its second phase and will continue until May 2012.

Marie will serve on the Membership Subcommittee which is charged with seeking and screening new members for the Pilot Program Committee. Marie said, "I am looking forward to contributing to the work involved in streamlining the discovery process and shaping procedures to resolve disputes regarding electronic discovery."
